The potential second round of federal stimulus funding being considered by Congress will likely include Transportation Enhancement funding. The House version of the bill requires projects to be under contract within 90 days of the stimulus bill's enactment. Jurisdictions were asked to propose Transportation Enhancement eligible projects that could meet the short deadline for delivery.

The AB2766 Motor Vehicle Emission Reduction Grant program, administered by the Monterey Bay Unified Air Pollution Control District, awarded funding to the Transportation Agency for the purchase and distribution of bicycle racks and lockers for employers and businesses in Monterey County.
