

## **Pre-Proposal Conference Questions and Answers**

## HIGHWAY 1 ELKHORN SLOUGH CORRIDOR CLIMATE RESILIENCY PROJECT

RFP DUE DATE: February 12, 2025, 12 PM Pacific Time

The Transportation Agency for Monterey County (TAMC) is requesting proposals from qualified consultants or consultant teams for the **Highway 1 Elkhorn Slough Corridor Climate Resiliency Project**. On Wednesday, December 18, 2024, TAMC held a Pre-Proposal Conference via Zoom from 10am-11am PST. The following document contains the notes of the question and answer portion of that conference. Notes are approximate and are not direct dictation of what was said. - Q: What is the correct name for Task 3? In the Task section of the Scope of Work, it's
  titled Existing Conditions and in the Deliverables section it is called the corridor
  assessment.
  - A: The Task is called Existing Conditions.
- 2. Q: What is the final report called? Consistency between what final report is called in deliverables/tasks.
  - A: Final Report is called Planning and Environmental Linkages Study
- 3. Q: Are the plans conceptual or engineering work?
  - A: The 30% Design plans are for conceptual work.
- 4. Q: TNC might provide support for virtual reality –will they be leading or supporting that effort?
  - A: Supporting.
- 5. Q:"Task 06: Technical Working Group Meetings Hold meetings with Caltrans, Steering Committee, and consultants. This task includes conducting meetings via appropriate formats on a weekly basis to provide status reports." Does this mean that there will be weekly meetings with all stakeholders?
  - A: Weekly meetings with these key personnel from Caltrans, TAMC and the consultant group should be included.
- 6. Q: In Task 5, there is a note that proposers should anticipate "up to 12 hours of public meetings at key project milestones" Does this include both general public meetings and stakeholder meetings as well? Or just public meetings?
  A: Just public meetings



- 7. Q: In Task 4, can you elaborate on the vision for alternatives to be considered? Inclusive of those in the AMBAG Study ...and beyond? A: Yes, alternatives beyond those in the AMBAG Study will be considered.
- 8. Q: Is there a set list of who we want to invite to stakeholder meetings?

  A: No just list of agencies that are stakeholders currently, reference the agency stakeholder list in SOW. TAMC has conducted outreach to many of these agencies regarding the project.
